Report dated 17.10.2015 sent by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Atma Ram, Sat Pal Singh, Gurdev Lal as well as of complainant Romesh Chander it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure, whereas, petitioner Amrik Singh did not turn up for making his statement.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.218 dated 25.07.2015 under Sections 465,467,468,471,120-B IPC Police Station, City Nakodar, District Jalandhar and all other

consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner No.1 Atma Ram, petitioner No.3 Sat Pal Singh and petitioner No.4. Gurdev lal, whereas, petition qua petitioner No.2 Amrik Singh stands dismissed.

Petition stands disposed off.
