Petitioner Anjali Dwivedi has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to register the FIR and to fairly and promptly investigate the matter in complaint dated 01.05.2013 (Annexure P-9), filed by the petitioner to Senior Superintendent of Police and to submit its report to concerned Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. has already been filed before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh and the same is pending without any proceeding.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

When the petitioner has already availing the remedy by filing application under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. then the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for registration of FIR is not maintainable.

In view of above, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the learned Illaqa Magistrate to consider the application filed by the petitioner under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. expeditiously as per law.
