The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.38, dated 29.4.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC, Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967 and Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegation against the petitioner is that he had obtained one fake passport in the name of Manjit Singh. He has been in custody for one month and fourteen days and that the other co-accused have been granted bail.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Kirpal

Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, SBS Nagar.

Petition stands disposed of.
