By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in appeal titled as Rekha Saini Vs. Hind Motors, pending in the Court of Addl. Sessions Judge, Chandigarh in complaint No. 1407 dated 15.02.2010.

The learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.
