AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the private respondents are not permitting the petitioners to fulfill the tender they have entered into transportation of food grains. He has further argued that in this connection the petitioner No.1 has moved a representation to the respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station, Bhogpur (Annexure P-4) and he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the him.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, the SHO, Police Station, Bhogpur to look into the matter and take whatever action is required on the said representation (Annexures P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
