Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.210 dated 14.9.2014, under Sections 376-D, 366, 341, 382, 506 and 148 IPC, registered at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the name of the petitioner does not find place in the FIR and he has been summoned only on an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. It is only during the

supplementary statement of Gurmeet Kaur, the name of the petitioner has figured.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner is involved in the case and there is a compact disk, prepared by the accused. However to a pointed query as to whether the petitioner is shown in the compact disk, learned counsel for the complainant is not able to convince this Court about the presence of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and it is only upon an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C., he has been summoned, in case, the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a week from today, the trial Court shall admit him on bail, however, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

The petition is disposed of.
