Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner had been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing. However, because of some communication gap, a factually incorrect averment was taken in the application for exemption moved on 28.8.2015. He further submits that petitioner is very much willing and ready to attend the court proceedings before the learned trial Court which is fixed for today itself. He submits that petitioner may be permitted to appear before the learned trial Court today at 3.30 pm.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and also keeping in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is permitted to appear before the learned trial Court today itself by 3.30 pm. Learned trial Court is directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner, keeping in view all the relevant facts and circumstances of the case, which shall be brought to its notice, at the instance of the petitioner and thereafter appropriate order shall be passed, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
