Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.46 dated 28.05.2012, under Section 279, 336, 337, 427 IPC, P.S. Phase-8, SAS Nagar, in a case of accidental injuries and damage, on the basis of compromise. The FIR was registered at the instance of Manjit Singh alleging that the petitioner while driving car in a negligent manner hit the motorcycle of respondent No.2. Compensation of Rs.55,000/- appears to have been paid to injured Madan Mohan.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded. A report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily and without any threat, coercion or undue influence. Relying upon judgment in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I do not find any reason not to appreciate the reasons of the compromise.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed, on the basis of compromise.
