The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.109 dated 08.07.2015, registered under Sections 323, 307, 342, 498-A, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kurali, Distt. S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

The complainant is present in person. She states that a compromise has been effected between the parties and she is happily residing at her matrimonial home.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined

the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.09.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
