Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.29 dated 28.03.2013 under Section 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply had been filed.

During the course of hearing, it has been brought to the notice of the Court that petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender. Said order is not even under challenge in the instant petition.
