Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the parties have married. The petitioners have filed an affidavit with regard to their majority and state that the age reflected in the certificate is not the actual date of birth. Sh. Ved Parkash father of petitioner No.1, who is present in the Court, states that petitioner No.2 is residing with his family as his daughter in law.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Though, as per record, the petitioners are minors but keeping in view, the threat perception, the life and liberty of the petitioners deserve to be protected.

In the circumstances, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Superintendent of Police, District Rewari who shall assess the threat perception and take all necessary steps to provide adequate safety and security to the petitioners and shall ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners are fully protected.

Nothing said in this order shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
