JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 571 dated 30.12.2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 394, 396 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 302 and 397, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh.

As per the allegations of eye-witness Amir Khan, accused-Vijay alongwith two other persons had waylaid the deceased-Raju and while snatching money from his pocket had also inflicted injuries with *Dandas* on the head, resulting into his death.

The petitioner is one of the other two persons whose name has surfaced in the investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent, assisted by ASI Bahadur Singh, submits that all the prosecution witnesses have since been examined except one who has been summoned for 23.12.2015.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, since the trial is at the fag end, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.

However, it is hoped that the trial Court would not unnecessary delay the conclusion of the trial.
