This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 452, 506 IPC and section 27 of Arms Act at Police Station City Fazilka, vide FIR No.110 dated 11.09.2015.

Learned State counsel (on the instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, who is present in court) submits that pursuant to order dated September 29, 2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and weapon has been recovered and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated September 29, 2015 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
