JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 33, dated 11.08.2015, under Sections 7 and 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered with Police Station S.V.B. Gurgaon.

As per allegation, the petitioner was working as Naib Tehsildar, Hathin, had demanded a bribe of Rs. 5,000/- for disbursement of a sum of Rs. 16,500/- as compensation for damage of wheat crop of the complainant. The petitioner was caught red handed and was arrested on 11.08.2015.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for almost two months and investigation qua whom is over.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Dalbir Singh, concedes that the investigation qua the petitioner is over and challan has not been filed.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Dharambir Singh deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Palwal.
