Petitioner seeks a direction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. from this court to SSP (Rural), Amritsar, for taking cognizance of the offence committed by the private respondents as mentioned in the complaint annexure P-1.

With the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner, I have gone through the contents of annexure P-1 and perusal of the contents of annexure P-1 indicates that it is a case of property dispute amongst the family members over partition and distribution of share of the parties pertaining to the land which is situated in Village Mulle Chak. Prima facie

no cognizable offence is made out from the complaint annexure P-1 as such I do not find it appropriate to issue any direction for consideration of representation annexure P-1.

Dismissed without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to avail any other legal remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
