This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered under Sections 307, 452, 382, 323, 295-A, 148, 149 IPC, 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act vide FIR No. 133 dated 8.7.2015 at Police Station, Division No.7, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no injury is attributed to the petitioner. He is in custody since 8.7.2015.

Prayer has been opposed by learned State counsel. According to him, entire mob assaulted the complainant and two other persons with intention to kill.

However, keeping in view the aforesaid contentions and period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
