Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.09.2014 and they are ready to face proceedings in accordance with law. The husband of the deceased was allowed regular bail by the Additional Sessions, Patiala and challan is yet to be presented in the Court.

Counsel for the State of Punjab, on instructions from HC Gurjeet Singh has conceded factual assertions and further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of and order dated 25.09.2014, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute subject to conditions incorporated therein.
