Report dated 08.10.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup>

Class, Fazilka has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Ram Dev and the accused persons namely Parveen Kumar @ Prince, Varinder Kumar and Gurmeet Singh @ Gurmeet Chand, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure, reporting further that petitioner No.2 Rajesh Kumar @ Khanni did not appear to make statement.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.231 dated 01.11.2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka under Sections 323/324/326/341/34 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners, except petitioner No.2 Rajesh Kumar @ Khanni, are quashed.

The petition stands allowed qua petitioners No.1, 3 and 4 namely Parveen Kumar @ Prince, Varinder Kumar and Gurmeet Singh @ Gurmeet Chand respectively and dismissed qua petitioner No.2 Rajesh Kumar @ Khanni.
