Counsel for the complainant-Komal has appeared and stated that the matter has been compromised.

Challan has been presented. On instructions from ASI-Mohinder Singh, learned State counsel informs that the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 07.01.2016.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the taking into consideration the law laid down in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal), 1052** and **B.S. Joshi and others Vs. State of Haryana and**

another 2003 (2) RCR (Criminal), 888 and it is ordered that the trial Court shall record the statements of the parties on 07.01.2016 regarding the matter having been compromised without any threat, coercion or undue influence. In case, the trial Court is satisfied that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably resolved by compromise, the trial Court shall permit the compounding of the offences against the petitioner and drop the proceedings. The said order will have the effect of acquittal on the basis of compounding.
