Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Jasvir Kumar alleging that he along with his brother Ravi Kumar had been attacked by the petitioner who was member of an unlawful assembly.

Perusal of the police file indicates that out of 12 accused named in the FIR, three persons have been found innocent. So far as petitioner is concerned, he has not been attributed any grievous injury. His culpability is alleged to be being member of unlawful assembly. Petitioner has already joined investigation.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C and subject to another condition that he will not commit any similar offence of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial and will not make any attempt to tamper with the evidence.
