This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.89 dated 23.06.2014, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

Vide order dated 27.10.2014, the parties were directed to appear before the learned Area Magistrate, for getting their

statements recorded. In compliance thereof, report of JMIC, dated 03.01.2015 has been received, wherein, it has been noticed that the compromise effected between the parties seems to be genuine.

In view of the above and the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**', **2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2014 (6) SCC, 466**, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.89 dated 23.06.2014, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner(s).
