This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.119 dated 11.06.2013 registered under Sections 279, 337 IPC, at Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and the trial Court may be directed to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court on or before 07.10.2015 and moves an application for

regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case within 2 days on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.
