Petitioner has filed second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.148 dated 04.06.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 307, 326, 450, 459, 460 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Heard.

Petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2014. As per the prosecution case, petitioner was armed with a *gandasa* at the time of occurrence and is attributed injury on the person of the injured-Harjinder Singh, which has been declared dangerous to life. However, challan has already been presented in the Court and conclusion of trial may take time. Injured-Harjinder Singh has been discharged from the hospital.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala.
