Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.197 dated 07.06.2014 under Section 22 of NDPS Act and Section 61 of Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Chherretta, District Amritsar.

Notice of motion was issued and the petitioner was granted interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that both the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court. He prays for allowing the present petition.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Davinder Singh, Police Station Chherretta, District Amritsar, submits that it is a matter of record that both the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court. He also verifies the fact that petitioner was driving the vehicle but he was not the owner of the said vehicle.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on merits at this stage, instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
