The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.70, dated 1.7.2015, registered under Sections 15/29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the alleged recovery in the present case is 60 kgs of poppy husk from four persons and that the petitioners have now been in custody for three months and four days, and no other case is pending against them.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab does not deny the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of

the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioners, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
