By this petition, the petitioner has alleged that he was severely beaten up by the police during the period of his arrest and police remand and has prayed that a medical board be constituted to report on his injuries, and medical aid be granted to him.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection, the petitioner has made a representation (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent, District Jail, Palwal and that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent to take immediate action on the said representation in view of the injuries on the person of the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent, District Jail, Palwal to

take immediate action on the representation (Annexure P-4), and in case the same has to be declined for any reason, to pass a speaking order within two days from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. Copy dasti on payment of usual charges.
