By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a cross version, vide rapat No. 15 dated 18.10.2014, under Sections 323, 326, 34 IPC, in case FIR No.145, dated 08.10.2014, registered under Sections 324, 323, 307, 325 r/w Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel contends that it is a case of version and cross version. He refers to the FIR (Annexure P-1), registered at the instance of the petitioner and Annexure P-2, the medical opinion,

wherein, injury No.1 on the person of the petitioner has been declared as dangerous to life and states that in pursuance of the order dated 07.01.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
