RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 326 dated 03.08.2011, under Sections 148, 149, 302, 120-B, 216, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 25/54/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder, has informed the Court that out of 60 prosecution witnesses, 30 have been examined.

The petitioner is in custody since 11.08.2011. In his cross-examination, the complainant (PW-2) has deposed that Sonu (present petitioner) was not carrying any grudge against him, as his dispute was with other accused on account of elections.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time to conclude, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
