This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.18 dated 11.01.2015 under Sections 177, 193, 194, 201, 304 and 34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that out of 18 witnesses cited by the prosecution 14 have been examined and 04 official witnesses remain who are bound for October 14, 2015. Prosecution shall not delay the proceedings.

In view of above, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh in case trial does not conclude within a period of three months.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
