

FAO No.3487 of 2004

Smt.Satto Devi and ors. Vs. Bhim Singh and ors.

(Appeal against the Award dated 8.5.2004 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridabad, in Claim Petition No.128).

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Two Insurance Companies were involved in the accident and were made liable to pay compensation to the extent of 50% each. Representative of the Oriental Insurance Company limited on 25th March, 2015, agreed to accept the enhancement if any made by National Insurance Company Limited. Today, National Insurance Company Limited has agreed to enhance compensation by ₹3,00,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to the same. Hence, a sum of ₹3,00,000/- (₹ Three Lac Only) is allowed to the appellants against both the Insurance Companies i.e. Oriental Insurance Company Limited and National Insurance Company Limited, liability 50% each. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1 – Satto Devi and would be deposited in her Syndicate Bank, Branch Hodal, Saving

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Bank Account No.82192200047747. Two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Companies to deposit the amount in the bank account of appellant No.1 – Satto Devi, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
