JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 36 dated 04.03.2013, for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34/120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered with Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar.

The name of the petitioner/accused and one of co-accused, namely, Lovepreet Singh have surfaced in the investigation, which have been corroborated by the prosecution with the roles attributed in the FIR. The petitioner is stated to be driving a motor-cycle whereas his co-accused-Lovepreet Singh was a pillion rider. They intercepted the complainant and the deceased with a motive to rob the deceased, who was admittedly a goldsmith. Co-accused-Lovepreet Singh is stated to have shot Madan Lal. The eye-witness of occurrence is the complainant-Sarwan Kumar. He has supported the case of the prosecution.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Premjit Singh, states that out of fourteen prosecution witnesses, six witnesses have been examined.

After arguing some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal the present petition.

In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
