Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.5 dated 03.01.2012, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Petitioner had absented during trial on 21.08.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 21.08.2015 as he had been advised bed rest. In this regard, learned counsel has placed reliance on medical certificate (Annexure P-4).

The said certificate was however, issued on 14.09.2015.

Hence, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made out.
