JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioners namely Salinder Singh @ Sarinder Kumar, Anjana Kumar @ Anju Bala and Ranjana Devi @ Makhni in case FIR No.33 dated 11.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 341, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

As per allegations three petitioners, out of whom two are ladies, along with three other co-accused allegedly attacked and inflicted injuries upon complainant Krishna Devi and her sister-in-law Neelam Devi.

The role attributed to two lady petitioners i.e. Petitioner nos.2 & 3 is that they were empty handed and pushed the complainant to the ground

whereas the petitioner no.1 is stated to have inflicted *dang* blow on the head of Neelam which has been opined to be simple in nature.

It is contended that assuming that the occurrence is true, no offence under Section 452 IPC would be made out which is a non bailable offence.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhdev Raj submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 01st of October, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
