Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No.188 dated 21.04.2013 under Sections 406, 420/120 IPC and Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967 registered at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that charge has been framed and the petitioner has been behind bars since 15.02.2014. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula
