Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.51 dated 13.7.2015 under Sections 324, 452 and 323 read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 307 and 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala.

This Court vide order dated 5.10.2015 has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 5.10.2015 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
