Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 288, dated 05.09.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 427, 285, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sirsa.

As per allegations, the petitioner alongwith others had ransacked the shop of complainant-Bhupender Sharma and also caused injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have arrived at a settlement and, therefore, no further investigations are required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Dharam Pal, does not refute the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, the interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court vide order dated 11.12.2015 is made absolute/confirmed.
