Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.2 was earlier married to Tara Rani. Petitioner No.2 and Tara Rani had got a divorce of decree on the basis of mutual consent on 14.09.2015. Photocopy of the judgment/decreed dated 14.09.2015 has been placed on record. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 20.09.2015. Photographs of the marriage ceremony are annexed as Annexure P-4. Learned counsel has also submitted that the petitioners have moved a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot (Annexure P-5), but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, District Pathankot, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioners and if required, necessary protection be provided to them.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
