RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondent Nos. 4 to 9, as the petitioners have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gian Singh, has informed the Court that statements of respondent Nos. 4 to 9 have been recorded to the effect that now they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and they will not interfere in their married life in future. Shingara Singh, father of Gurdeep Singh-petitioner No.2 also made his statement to the same effect.

In view of the statements made by respondent Nos. 4 to 9, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
