In this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.109, dated 09.04.2014, registered under Sections 302, 201 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Ganur, District Sonapat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant, Ram Kumar, Sarpanch and other material prosecution witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution and have turned hostile.

However, the learned State counsel submits that in

pursuance of the disclosure statement, a knife used in the crime, was recovered from the petitioner. The trial is at the fag end.

Considering the fact that the trial is at the fag end and only 3 witnesses remains to be examined, this Court is not inclined to grant the bail to the petitioner as the impact of the statements made by the prosecution witnesses shall be examined by the trial Court at the appropriate stage.

Dismissed.
