Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Gurinder Kaur alleging that she was married to petitioner on 27.09.2009. One child was born from the wedlock but the petitioner along with his family members has maltreated, tortured and beaten the complainant on the pretext of bringing less dowry. An attempt was made to kill the complainant by setting her on fire.

During course of investigation, it has also been reported that the petitioner has abducted the younger sister of the complainant. Whereabouts of younger sister of the complainant are also not known to the complainant. In this context, family members of the petitioner have also furnished their statements before the police as well as before this Court in the shape of affidavits.

Taking into consideration the totality of the circumstances, I am of the opinion that the activities of the petitioner constitute severe type of cruelty.

No ground is made out to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
