Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.94 dated 04.07.2014, under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kotisah Khan, District Moga.

Following order was passed by this Court on 19.11.2014:-

“List again on 29.1.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact, petitioner had executed a Power of Attorney in favour of his son who was looking after the business of the mill.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Pritam Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 19.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
