Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case DDR No.16 dated 03.10.2014, registered at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar (Rural) under Sections 452, 354, 427, 148, 149 IPC in main case FIR No.194 dated 01.10.2014, registered at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar (Rural) under Sections 307, 452, 427, 506, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

It is a case of version and cross version. The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in cross version. They have already joined the investigation and are not required for any further

investigation or interrogation purposes nor anything is to be recovered from them. The main case, in which the petitioners are on complainant's side, is under Section 307 IPC. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.02.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
