Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in this case a cheque of Rs.150000/- was issued on 19.4.2013 and that the accused wants to compromise the matter but the complainant is not agreeing to it.

I have gone through the facts mentioned in the complaint. If there is a subsequent move for compromise that can be brought to the notice of the trial Court and matter can be decided. However, present complaint cannot be quashed on the ground of misuse of process of Court.
