The instant petition is for regular bail in FIR No. 197 dated 14.10.2012, registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana.

The record reveals that the petitioner has been acquitted on 31.07.2015.

During the course of hearing, certain shortcomings were noticed regarding non-production of under-trials before the Court, due to which delay had occurred in disposal of trial. The Court took serious note of the matter and explanation was sought from the authorities concerned of the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh about the arrangements made for production of under-trials before the Court and the steps taken to improve the situation.

The replies by way of affidavits have been filed by the concerned State Authorities and this Court is satisfied with the steps taken in this regard. No further orders are required to be passed, at this stage.

The petition stands disposed of.
