This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No.143 dated 6.10.2010 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Ladowal, District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated 16.10.2014, the Court had said that the parties may appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with regard to compromise.

Report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana that the statements were made voluntarily. The complainant made a statement before the trial Court that he had settled the matter with the accused as the petitioner Nachhattar Kaur is the sister, petitioner- Surjit Singh is husband of Nachhattar Kaur while Harinder Singh is the nephew of the complainant being his sister's son.

Counsel for the parties also stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Since the parties are very closely related and in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the abovesaid FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.

Disposed of.
