The petitioner has been arrested in a case of the year 2006 under Section 15 of the NDPS Act after having escaped from the spot when two co-accused were apprehended. Petitioner has been arrested after a period of eight years. The identity of the petitioner will certainly be a debatable issue.

On asking of the Court, it has been informed that petitioner is not involved in any other case, therefore, he can be granted the concession of bail. It is ordered that petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not commit the similar offence and will not absent himself without any sufficient cause.
