Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.31 dated 18.08.2015, under Sections 354, 452 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

While issuing notice motion, following order was passed by this Court on 06.10.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have amicably settled their dispute.

Notice of motion for 10.12.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Tarsem Kumar has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 06.10.2015, is made absolute.
