Petitioner is nominated as an accused in case FIR no.19 dated 15.3.2009 for offences punishable under Sections 326,324, 323, 148,149 IPC registered with PS City South Moga and is facing trial. The case is at the stage of recording of evidence of the prosecution.

The grievance of the petitioner is against the order dated 4.9.2015(P-2) whereby the learned JMIC,Moga has declared him proclaimed offender.

It is contended that the petitioner was admitted in a Drug Rehabilitation Center and therefore his non-appearance before the trial court on the dates fixed was not intentional.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the interim protection, the petitioner has surrendered

before the trial court and has been granted interim bail on 13.10.2015 to join the trial. It is thus submitted that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, interim bail granted by the trial court is confirmed.

Disposed of accordingly.
