Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeks quashing of order dated 26.8.2014 (Annexure P-7) in FIR No.8 dated 2.6.2014 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station NRI Amritsar, District Amritsar, whereby petitioners were declared proclaimed offenders.

In view of the order passed in CRM-M-22959-2015 (Amarjit Kaur and another v. State of Punjab), whereby this very FIR has been ordered to be quashed on the basis of an amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, by way of compromise, the present petition deserves to be accepted. It is so said, because petitioner No.2-husband was already staying abroad when the FIR was registered, whereas petitioner No.1 was also not properly served before declaring her proclaimed offender.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the order dated 26.8.2014 is hereby quashed.

Disposed of, accordingly.
