Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking appropriate directions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed, they finally approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot by way of representation dated 28.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot-respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation within reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot-

respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and consider the grievance raised by the petitioners in their representation dated 28.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
